- Sleeping bag
- Camping mat or inflatable mattress
- Pillow
- Rucksack (to carry things to the protest)
- Drink container
- Thermos flask (for a hot drink during the day)
- Nibbles for the journeys
- Lunch for Sunday
- Knife, fork and spoon
- Plate
- Bowl
- Mug
- Spare clothes (bring spare in case it gets wet)
- Warm coat
- Hat (that covers your ears) / balaclava (or both)
- Gloves / mittens
- Scarf
- Warm jumpers – preferably fleece, not cotton (bring spare in case it gets wet)
- Warm socks
- Waterproof jacket (great protection against wind and/or rain)
- Waterproof trousers (great protection against wind and/or rain)
- Sturdy boots or wellies
- Wash kit
- Towel
- Nightwear
- Toilet paper (for use at the Faslane site)
- Camera (and batteries / charger)
- Carrier bags (useful for wet or muddy gear)
- Mobile phone
- Sense of humour ☺

- Swiss Army Knife or anything else that could be seen as a weapon
- Drugs or alcohol
- Diary
- Mobile phone - risk of confiscation if arrested (Leave with a non-arrestable person ? This is up to you.)
